IV began in 2005 as leaders from several churches and ministries became burdened for homeowners who live in substandard conditions because they are unable to pay for necessary repairs.

So far, 35+ homes in the northern Shenandoah Valley of Virginia have received facelifts that include drywall replacement, structural repairs, painting, yard work, flooring and more.

Households are screened for financial need by *Help With Housing* based in Berryville, VA.





How It Works

Impact the Valley (IV) is a mission trip without the trip

Project coordinators select homes that need repairs. These homes belong to low-income elderly or disabled people and are located in Front Royal/Warren County or Winchester/Frederick County.

Youth and adult volunteers, skilled professionals and supervisors will work on these homes for five days to do repairs and meet other needs as they arise. They return to their lodging each evening for worship, recreation and fellowship. Because Impact the Valley is a local mission, volunteers can come for the entire week or just a day. All-adult teams are welcome.

IV strives to keep costs low for participants by seeking support from the community and other donors.

If you have a passion to change your community and want to take your group on a mission trip, but couldn't afford it, IV can be the opportunity for you.

IV is a Christian event, not affiliated with any single denomination or church.

Lodging will be at the Front Royal RV Campground. Cabin space for up to 90 volunteers and campsites are available. *Cabin space awarded on a firstcome, first-served basis.*
